The Department of Homeland Security has designated the food industry as a “Critical Infrastructure Industry”, and we take seriously our responsibility to play our part in maintaining the food supply chain.

It is reassuring to know that the Food & Drug Administration has advised that “there is no evidence of food or packaging being associated with the transmission of COVID-19”.

At the same time, we want to ensure the safety of our employees and the food supply itself. We have instituted additional cleaning at all our sites, employees that can have been instructed to work from home, and we have restricted travel and outside visitors.

To support those impacted economically by the COVID-19 pandemic, we donated three truckloads of peanut butter and assorted snack products to the Chicago Food Depository to aid their efforts to provide meals for children out of school and families in need.

We will continue to work hard to provide safe, healthy, nutritional products and do what we can to take care of our employees and communities.
